9 Art Exhibitions Worth Masking Up for This Spring Man Ray & Francis Picabia

An exhibition at Vito Schnabel puts two giants of the avantgarde into compelling conversation. Edited to just nine paintings spanning some 30 years, *Man Ray & Picabia* looks at both artists' powerfully unconventional visions, each variously rooted in (and influential to) the worlds of Dada, Cubism, and Surrealism. A number of the works haven't been on public display for decades.
